Spilled Ink:

I like theology. The doctrine of Christ or humanity and salvation are fascinating. I like interpreting the ancient text to find the lesson for us today. The more I learn, the more I stand in awe of God who explains all things, right down to the bottom.

Not everyone shares my interest in theology. A story of paddling, drifting, or sailing down the river with Jesus is easier for us to tell, and much more engaging (this, too, is theology but don't tell anyone!). Stories of what we have seen along the way, stories of what we believe Jesus is doing among us, how he helped or changed or healed you or our community can draw interest. Honest stories about fear and doubt and disobedience - and grace of God that found us anyway can evoke a curious question.

"Please pass the faith," we're saying this fall. Last week we practiced telling river stories, stories of the river of life flowing from Jesus through us (**see John 7**). Keep practicing that story. Tell it over supper or when you walk along the road (**see Deuteronomy 6**). You and others will be blessed. God will be praised.
