Last week six people from our church attended the Helping without Harming workshop in Nanaimo, presented by World Renew and Diaconal Ministries Canada. We covered a lot more ground than can be packed into this little space. Here are some highlights:

- 1. *Prepositions count.*** We often do work for people to help them. That's good, but even better is doing work with them.
- 2. *An important rule:*** Never do for someone what they can do themselves. They may need help or encouragement or instruction, but as above, work with people.
- 3. *Start with assets.*** First ask, "What do you have? What can you do? What are you good at?" Build on what is already present - what God has already begun.
- 4. *Never assume that we know what is best for others.*** If you want to help, the first three things to do are listen, listen and listen.
- 5. *Go humbly.*** Before we ask what we can teach someone, consider asking, "What can I learn from this person?"

Ask a deacon or a member of the **We ♥ PA** crew about the workshop; we might stammer through an answer, but your questions will help us sort out what comes next.
