On Saturday, the council will visit The Tapestry CRC, a multi-ethnic, multi-site CRC in Richmond. The original Richmond CRC closed some years ago and made a fresh start as "The Tapestry." They have planted a church in the Marpole district of Vancouver and launched the "The Tap Coquitlam" which is a restart of the original CRC in Coquitlam. Recently, they have started a Saturday evening church in their own building. We don't believe they have a secret recipe for doing church but they seem to be doing things that God is blessing. We want to go and ask questions about vision and staff and reaching people outside of our church while still caring deeply for people in the church. We will meet with several different leaders there and between those meetings have time to debrief and consider what they have learned can help us in Port Alberni.
